Wilson Talent Center Seeks Distinguished Alumni for Wall-of-Fame Recognition

The Wilson Talent Center (WTC), formerly known as the Capital Area Career Center (CACC), is seeking distinguished alumni to apply for its sixth annual Wall-of-Fame recognition event on Thursday, March 12, 2020. To be eligible for consideration, alumni of the WTC/CACC must meet the following criteria:

- Individual must have successfully completed their WTC/CACC program
- Individual must be a minimum of five years removed from their time at the WTC/CACC
- Individual should be working in a related field to their choice of study while at the WTC/CACC

“Our graduates move on, continue their education and make wonderful contributions to their industries and communities, and we want to recognize their accomplishments,” states Joe Wenzel, principal at the WTC. “It is also meaningful for our current students to see where these professionals started, way back in high school, and the success they have achieved since their time here.”

Nominations are due to the WTC no later than January 30, 2020. Self-nominations are encouraged. Those who are selected agree to have their name and photo used in press materials supporting the event.
