In other action, the Board:

- Approved the Resolutions of Tribute for Kayla Nohel and Paula Johnson, as presented.
- Approved the Mason Communications Services agreement dated July 1, 2023, through June 30, 2024 for a base contract amount of \$39,000/year and a not to exceed amount of \$48,000/year.
- Approved the annual cost for the Workforce Management System from Kronos SaaSh4, Inc. which
 includes annual subscription license, maintenance/support, and web-based hosting in the amount not to
 exceed \$44,000.
- Approved a single-source purchase from Pearson Education (Upper Saddle River, NJ) at a price of \$7.00 per student for an estimated amount of \$81,000 for Pearson aimswebPlus subscriptions for our local districts and participating public school academies, for August 1, 2023, to July 31, 2024.
- Approved a single-source purchase from Spring Math, Ties (Saint Paul, MN) at a price of \$9.90 per student for an estimated amount of \$21,000 for Spring Math subscriptions for our local districts and participating public school academies for August 1, 2023, to July 31, 2024.
- Approved the purchase of individual 12-month copier support and maintenance agreements for 20 copiers for the 2023-24 school year, from Lowery Corporation d/b/a Applied Imaging for a total estimated group cost of \$30,000.
- Approved the purchase order with CODA Music Therapy Services LLC to provide Music Therapy/Adapted Music Education services from August 2023 June 2024, at \$71.00 per hour for group sessions, for a total amount not to exceed \$51,254.
- Approved the additional 1.0 FTE for the position of Consultant, Newcomer English learner.
- Approved the revised job description and reclassification for the Assistant School Nurse position.
- Approved the increase in special education FTE as presented.
- Approved the increase of 1.0 FTE for an Early Childhood Specialist.
- Approved the science curriculum for the Emotionally Impaired and Adjudicated Youth Programs, as presented.
