




BOARD BRIEFS

March 17, 2026

Presentation

- Authorization of Recurring Vendor Contracts
 - Kent ISD for July 1, 2025, through June 30, 2027, in estimated amount of \$125,000 annually or \$250,000 total for PowerSchool Special Education (MiPSE) software data and hosting services for Ingham ISD and participating consortium districts



In other action, the Board:

- Authorized the approval of a three-year agreement with Maner Costerisan to provide audit services for fiscal years 2025-26, 2026-27, and 2027-28. The base fees are \$43,000, \$44,500, and \$46,000, with a contingency of up to \$5,000 per year for additional work related to new accounting standards, additional major programs under the single audit, or auditing of new bond issuances, if required.
- Approved the summer purchase of computers and related equipment for the 2026-27 school year in the amount not to exceed \$400,000.
- Awarded the purchase of a 2026 Chevrolet Silverado EV LT truck to LaFontaine Automotive Group of Plymouth, MI in an amount not to exceed \$46,070.00.
- Approved the new position, Administrative Assistant, Information Technology Services and reduction of 1.0 FTE Help Desk Technician position, as presented.
