QUESTIONS AND ANSWERS**

Question:

For the site list provided do you want dedicated internet or WAN? Can Ingham ISD provide the speed desired at each location?

Answer:

Ingham ISD’s invitation to bid is requesting internet only. The collaboration currently has a leased WAN service in place which is not included in this bid. Our configuration and request is that bandwidth be quoted in such a way that would allow us to deliver service to the aggregation point at Ingham ISD, as well as consider bandwidth delivered directly to Okemos Public Schools and Lansing Public Schools.

- 5Gb - 10Gb (expandable to 12Gb) to Ingham Intermediate School District at 2630 W. Howell Rd, Mason, Michigan 48854 – serving Dansville, East Lansing, Haslett, Holt, Leslie, Mason, Stockbridge, Waverly, Webberville and Williamston (all listed below). These districts access the available bandwidth across our WAN per our consortium’s configuration and resources.
- 0Gb - 1Gb (expandable to 2Gb) to Okemos Public Schools at 4406 N. Okemos Road, Okemos, Michigan 48864 – service is specific to Okemos.
- 5Gb - 10Gb (expandable in 1Gb increments) to Lansing Public Schools at 5815 Wise Rd., Lansing, Michigan 48911 – service is specific to Lansing.

Would you consider shared internet access at each site, or do you require dedicated?

Answer:

We cannot currently consider individual access to each local district. Our current configuration requires bandwidth to be delivered to the aggregation point. Two districts may choose to have bandwidth delivered directly to them, these are Okemos Public Schools and Lansing Public Schools whom we are requesting have the option for delivery directly to their district instead of through the aggregation point.

We understand that service SLAs are tied to the demarcation point of service.
