Public Acts 123 & 124 Modifications to the required credits are allowed only through a personal curriculum (PC). A high school diploma may be awarded to a pupil who successfully completes his or her personal curriculum even if it does not meet the requirements of the Michigan Merit Standard.

	Request to discuss personal curriculum options with a counselor.								
	A student who wishes to complete additional credit, beyond the number that is already required, in English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, or a Language Other Than English, by modifying a credit from Social Studies, Health & Physical Education, or Visual, Performing & Applied Arts. Modification to Social Studies is allowed only after completing 2 credits of Social Studies that includes Civics. (English Language Arts and Science credit requirements are not subject to modification under this subsection of personal curriculum.)								
	A student who wishes to modify the mathematics requirement after successfully completing 2 credits of Mathematics, as stipulated in the Michigan Merit Curriculum, and meets 1 or more of the following: 1. Has successfully completed the same content as the first semester of Algebra II; 2. Enrolls in a formal career and technical education program or curriculum and, in that program or curriculum, successfully completes the same content as 1 semester of Algebra II. (Note: All students must successfully complete at least 1 mathematics (or math-related) course during his or her final year of high school.)								
	A student with a disability who needs to modify any of the credit requirements. The modification, which is necessary because of the pupil's disability, is to be consistent with both the pupil's Educational Development Plan and Individualized Education Program (IEP). The IEP will identify the appropriate course of study and the supports, accommodations, and modifications necessary to allow the pupil to progress in the curricular requirements. The PC will identify modifications to the Michigan Merit Standards.								
	A student who has transferred from out-of-state, or from a non-public school, with two or more years of high school credit. The PC plan must include a Civics credit, and Mathematics (or math-related) course in their final year of high school. If the student is enrolled in a Michigan public high school for more than one full year, the final year of mathematics must be the equivalent of Algebra I or a math course normally taken after completing Algebra I.
