## Two Ingham ISD Employees Win Honors from the Michigan Association of Career and Technical Education


On Monday, January 30, Scott Westenberg, Automotive Technology Instructor, and Lindy Daman, College and Career Preparation and Assessment Coordinator, were recognized at the Michigan Career Education Conference by the Michigan Association for Career and Technical Education (MI ACTE). Westenberg received the 2023 MI ACTE Lifetime Achievement Award and Daman received the 2023 MI ACTE Counseling and Career Preparation Professional of the Year Award. Both Westenberg and Daman are on staff at the Wilson Talent Center.

Westenberg is in his thirty-first year as an instructor of the Automotive Technology program. Throughout his career he continues to remain up to date on instructional strategies, making sure his students have the best Career Technical Education (CTE) experience possible.
